

The United Community Living Center is a group of concerned individuals forming a non-profit for the purpose of creating housing opportunities in the Capital City. Our proposed shelter and supported housing, located between Augusta's downtown and Western Avenue, will provide low barrier shelter beds for up to 40 guests and up to 16 affordable, supported housing units.

Services located on site will include access to community health workers (CHW) to support our guests in navigating health and social service systems. We will endeavor to inspire our guests to work toward their goals. Education will be provided in multiple areas including, but not limited to employment, finance, nutrition and managing medical and mental health conditions. Recovery and peer support services may also be available onsite or by referral to existing resources. These opportunities will inspire hope and provide the skills needed to move forward.

Available resources will include a computer lab and a teaching kitchen. We will provide supportive services for attaining formal education in order to help guests to improve their personal situation and lead to opportunities for advancement in employment and increased independence for those who are interested. Services will be tailored to the individual guest and what they find meaningful. We will support guests in their pursuit of housing independence.

MISSION

Green Street Living Center will provide a sense of safety and security to individuals experiencing homelessness. Guests will utilize shelter housing or supported housing and will have access to community health workers to support them in moving forward. We will offer resources, opportunities and education to help them develop skills to encourage successful independence.

VISION

To be a helping hand, providing support and safety to individuals experiencing housing insecurity, and instilling hope for the future.

In order to move this project forward we will be seeking business and community support. We will engage with other social and health organizations to identify and support the needs of the Augusta area homeless. We will be holding focus groups and listening sessions to help us better understand these needs and to tailor our services to meet these needs whenever possible. We will also be seeking funding to support this worthwhile effort. Fundraising and grants will be utilized for this project. Donations are currently being accepted through a partner organization while we are securing our non-profit status.



Community makes all things possible. Starting with 20 year-round low barrier shelter beds and 16 supported low barrier housing units, the Green Street United Community Living Center (UCLC) will provide individuals with a unique opportunity to change the direction of their lives.

Simply put, the UCLC will provide shelter and services for a population in Augusta that is falling through the cracks. With community health services on site, people with mental and physical health issues, substance abuse issues, financial issues and more will be given the opportunity to improve their lives. They will be encouraged to seek the services that exist in Augusta to help them grow and live successfully within our Augusta community. How do you do that when you're living curbside?

When given stability and opportunity, the individuals you see hanging out, walking with all their worldly possessions or living in a tent can get healthy, find recovery, seek education, and get jobs. They can find purpose and they can be successful, just like you.
